KAKADU SPEED PACK SOFTWARE COMMERCIAL LICENSE AGREEMENT

Permission to use the KAKADU Speed Pack Software is conditional upon you, the Licensee, agreeing to the terms and conditions set out below and paying the License Fee. Do not purchase nor install KAKADU Speed Pack Software until you have read and accepted all the terms of the license and agree to become a licensee of the KAKADU Speed Pack Software.

YOUR PURCHASE AND/OR INSTALLATION OF THE KAKADU SPEED PACK SOFTWARE IS DEEMED TO BE YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THE FOLLOWING TERMS. ONCE YOU HAVE MADE PAYMENT FOR OR INSTALLED THE KAKADU SPEED PACK SOFTWARE, YOU ARE BOUND BY THESE TERMS.

You agree that the following terms constitute the COMPLETE and EXCLUSIVE statement of agreement between you and NEWSOUTH INNOVATIONS PTY LIMITED with respect to the KAKADU Speed Pack Software and SUPERSEDES all proposals and prior agreements, oral or written, and any other communications between us relating to the KAKADU Speed Pack Software.

1. **LICENSE GRANT.** NewSouth Innovations Pty Limited ACN 000 263 025 (“NSi”) hereby grants to the Licensee a non-exclusive license to install and use the KAKADU Speed Pack Software and accompanying documentation as provided herein. The License to the KAKADU Speed Pack Software and documentation including enhancements are personal to the Licensee, and the intellectual property rights in the KAKADU Speed Pack Software shall at all times remain the property of NSi, and the Licensee shall have no right, title, or interest therein, except as expressly set forth in this Agreement.
2. **DEFINITIONS.**
 - 2.1. **Affiliate:** A person or legal entity which is controlled by, or controls, or is under common control with the Licensee. Control means (i) beneficial ownership of at least fifty percent (50%) of the voting securities of a corporation or other business organization with voting securities, or (ii) a fifty percent (50%) or greater interest in the profits or capital of a partnership or other business organisation without voting securities.
 - 2.2. **Application:** Compiled code generated using the KAKADU Speed Pack Software or Reusable Code derived from the KAKADU Speed Pack source code, or any part thereof. No part of an Application is Reusable Code.
 - 2.3. **Deployment:** Supply of one or more Applications by the Licensee to end-users (which include the Licensee’s employees and contractors) whether directly or indirectly through Third Parties.

Deploy shall be similarly construed.

- 2.4 **Deployment Instance:** Deployment for use on:
- 2.4.1 a single computing platform for the benefit of any number of users provided that only one user may use the Application at any given time; or
 - 2.4.2 multiple computing platforms for the benefit of one designated end-user provided that the designated end-user executes the Application on only one of those computing platforms at any time.
- 2.5 **Deployment Quota:** the specified number of Deployment Instances permitted to be Deployed by the Licensee or Deployed by a Third Party as a result of On-Licensing, as set out in the Details or as augmented by the Licensee from time to time.
- 2.6 **Details:** means the details as completed and set out in the online or fax order form accompanying and forming part of this license agreement.
- 2.7 **Development Use:** The installation or use of the KAKADU Speed Pack Software or Reusable Code by the Licensee or an Affiliate, for the purpose of developing Applications on behalf of the Licensee (or an Affiliate) or in the performance of services for Third Parties who engage the Licensee or Affiliate.
- 2.8 **Field of Deployment:** shall mean the field of deployment specified in the Details.
- 2.9 **KAKADU Speed Pack Software:** The KAKADU Speed Pack Software and related electronic documentation provided to the Licensee at the time of purchase of this license, together with any improvements or enhancements if any made available by NSi to the Licensee from time to time.
- 2.10. **License Fee:** The license fee specified in the Details.
- 2.11 **Licensee:** The legal entity that has purchased the KAKADU Speed Pack Software and is granted the license under this Agreement. Reference to the Licensee shall include its officers, employees and contractors.
- 2.12 **On-License:** The supply of any software or software components developed using the KAKADU Speed Pack Software to a Third Party to enable that Third Party to use, further develop and Deploy Applications created by it. **On-Licensing** will be similarly construed.
- 2.13 **Reusable Code:** The original KAKADU Speed Pack source code, as distributed with this license, with or without modifications, and exclusions, made either by the Licensee, NSi or any other party. Reusable Code also includes any intermediate compiled form, such as dynamically or statically linked libraries, which provides means of exploiting the functionality of the KAKADU Speed Pack Software tools in new Applications.

- 2.14 **Third Party:** Any person or legal entity which is not NSi, the Licensee or an Affiliate.
3. The Licensee shall have the right to Development Use of KAKADU Speed Pack Software. All copies of the software shall contain all copyright and proprietary notices from the original source code.
 4. The Licensee shall have the right to Deployment of Applications provided that
 - 4.1. All Deployed Applications must contain notification that they were developed using the KAKADU Speed Pack Software.
 - 4.2. Deployment by the Licensee is limited in number to the Deployment Quota and exercisable only within the specified Field of Deployment.
 5. The Licensee shall have the right to On-License to Third Parties subject to the provisions in clause 6 and clause 7.
 6. All software or software components distributed pursuant to clause 5:
 - 6.1 must contain significant differences in flexibility and capability additional to those already provided by the KAKADU Speed Pack Software as supplied to the Licensee; and
 - 6.2 must allow access to KAKADU Speed Pack Software functionality only through software or other interfaces created by the Licensee which are materially different from those provided by the original KAKADU Speed Pack software supplied to the Licensee.
 7. The Licensee must ensure that any Deployment by a Third Party of Applications supplied by the Licensee pursuant to clause 5:
 - 7.1 is restricted to the Licensee's Field of Deployment; and
 - 7.2 does not, when taken in aggregate with the Licensee's all other Deployment instances within the relevant Field of Deployment, exceed the Licensee's Deployment Quota in that Field of Deployment.
 8. The Licensee shall have the right to distribute Reusable Code to a Third Party provided that the Third Party has given the Licensee documentary evidence that it independently holds a valid and binding license from NSi to use the KAKADU Speed Pack Software. All copies of such distributed Reusable Code shall contain all copyright and propriety notices from the original source code. The Licensee must provide NSi with a copy of evidence of compliance upon request.
 9. The Licensee shall not reverse engineer (the whole or any part of) the KAKADU software or Reusable Code except as expressly permitted by sections 47B(3), 47C, 47D, 47E or 47F of the *Copyright Act 1968 (Cth)*.

10. The Licensee shall have the right to use the KAKADU Speed Pack Software in accordance with this Agreement indefinitely, subject to the termination provisions in this Agreement.
11. The Licensee and its Affiliates must hold the KAKADU Speed Pack software (including the source code) in strict confidence at all times and not use the KAKADU Speed Pack Software, or permit it to be used, except in accordance with this Agreement.
12. NSi may terminate this license grant, by written notice to the Licensee if the Licensee breaches any term of this Agreement.
13. Absent appropriate exemption certificate(s), Licensee shall pay all taxes, duties, or customs, except for taxes based on NSi net income.
14. Licensee shall not use the name, trade names or trade marks of NSi or any of its Affiliates in any advertising, promotional literature or any other material, whether in written, electronic, or other form, distributed to any Third Party, except in the form provided by NSi, and then solely for purposes of identifying NSi software.
15. This license is not transferable to a third party and may not be sub-licensed to any other person. This license may be transferred to an Affiliate at no cost provided that NSi is notified in writing of the transfer and the Affiliate accepts these same terms and conditions.
16. THE KAKADU SOFTWARE IS A COLLECTION OF SOFTWARE TOOLS, WHICH MAY NOT BE APPROPRIATE FOR THE INTENDED PURPOSE. NSI DOES NOT WARRANT THAT: THE OPERATION OF THE KAKADU SOFTWARE WILL BE UNINTERRUPTED OR ERROR FREE; THE KAKADU SOFTWARE IS FIT FOR ANY PARTICULAR PURPOSE; OR THE KAKADU SOFTWARE OR ITS USE DOES NOT INFRINGE THE RIGHTS OF A THIRD PARTY. TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW ALL WARRANTIES, TERMS AND CONDITIONS NOT EXPRESSLY INCLUDED IN THIS AGREEMENT ARE EXCLUDED. NSI SHALL HAVE NO LIABILITY FOR INDIRECT OR CONSEQUENTIAL LOSS (WHETHER FORESEEABLE OR OTHERWISE), AND LOSS OF PROFITS, LOSS OF BUSINESS, LOSS OF OPPORTUNITY, OR LOSS OF USE OF ANY COMPUTER HARDWARE OR SOFTWARE, RESULTING FROM THE USE OF THE KAKADU SOFTWARE.

THE KAKADU SOFTWARE SHOULD NOT BE RELIED ON AS THE SOLE BASIS TO SOLVE A PROBLEM WHOSE INCORRECT SOLUTION COULD RESULT IN INJURY OR LOSS TO PERSON OR PROPERTY. IF THE SOFTWARE IS EMPLOYED IN SUCH A MANNER, IT IS AT THE LICENSEE'S OWN RISK AND NSI EXPLICITLY DISCLAIMS ALL LIABILITY FOR SUCH MISUSE TO THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW.

NSI'S LIABILITY FOR MATTERS IN RELATION TO WHICH LIABILITY BY LAW CANNOT BE EXCLUDED OR LIMITED SHALL NOT BE EXCLUDED OR LIMITED. EXCEPT AS AFORESAID, ALL OTHER LIABILITY OF NSI WHETHER IN RELATION TO BREACH OF CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE) OR OTHERWISE SHALL

NOT IN AGGREGATE EXCEED THE AMOUNT PAID TO NSI UNDER THIS AGREEMENT FOR THE KAKADU SOFTWARE.

SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OR LIMITATION OF WARRANTIES AND LIABILITY SO THE ABOVE EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS MAY NOT APPLY TO THE LICENSEE.

WHERE AVAILABLE, NSI'S LIABILITY UNDER TERMS AND CONDITIONS THAT ARE IMPLIED BY LAW AND WHICH MAY NOT BE EXCLUDED, IS LIMITED TO, AT NSI'S OPTION, RESUPPLY OF THE KAKADU SOFTWARE OR PAYMENT OF THE COSTS OF RESUPPLY OF THE KAKADU SOFTWARE.

17. To the extent any law, treaty, or regulation is in conflict with this Agreement, the conflicting terms of this Agreement shall be superseded only to the extent necessary by such law, treaty, or regulation. If any provision of this Agreement shall be otherwise unlawful, void or otherwise unenforceable, that provision shall be enforced to the maximum extent permissible. In either case, the remainder of this Agreement shall not be affected.
18. This Agreement contains the entire understanding of the Parties and may not be modified or amended except by written instrument, executed by authorized representatives of NSi and Licensee.
19. This Agreement is governed by the laws of New South Wales, Australia, and the parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of that State and the Commonwealth of Australia.
